Overview

The data that Euronav Ltd collects on you is very limited in nature, we don't need to know your age, ethnic origins, gender etc., for any of our operations and will never ask for it or record it if accidentally given.

Euronav just stores personal information required to process/service an order or a request from yourself for information such a subscribed list.

What data do we collect?

Euronav Ltd collects certain types of data about you

1. Information required to process an order or service you place or have with us.

The information gathered is the information required to process the order and is given to us by you. This may include, your name, Company/Organisation, email address, physical address, credit card or other similar data required to process your order.

This data is maintained in our system for as long as required to meet accounting and financial, tax obligations etc, For example sale receipts and invoices and to support your products or to send notices of product updates you have purchased.

This data will be kept securely within the Euronav system, unless its required to be sent to a credit/debit card processor for payment, debt collection service or under legal disclosure requirements by the UK government/court.

Where a service is supplied by a third party such as the UKHO/Admiralty the information required to register you with the third party will be passed to them when processing the order. Authorization is implied when you place this type of order with us.

When is the data removed:

Any information no longer required to service or support your products such as credit card information is removed from our system after the transaction is complete, except where you have explicitly requested us to securely maintain the information for making repeat purchases on the account. This is the exception rather than the rule

The data used to maintain your account in terms of legal and regulatory requirements (invoices/receipts/licences etc) can be retained indefinitely and is done so for at least 7 years. This data cannot be requested to be forgotten until legal expiration.

2. When you sign up for a news letter or similar.

To receive these you will need to subscribe to the required contact method.

You can unsubscribe at any time.

To unsubscribe either click unsubscribed on the last email sent or contact sales@euronav.co.uk using the subscriber email with Unsubscribed in the title.

This will stop all further communications from us accept those required to provide a product or service you have ordered such as S57 ENC updates

If you require these to be stopped you will need to contact sales, this will result in the loss of the service you have paid for.

3. Website cookies

Or similar technology might be used to track your movements across the Euronav Ltd web sites, this information is not correlated with you unless you use the shop and place an order see (1) above.

4. If you work for Euronav Ltd (permanent, temporary or contract)

Personal data will be securely stored and will be used in managing your time with the company such as pay, holiday entitlement, benefits, pensions, career advancement or disciplinary matters or as required by law.

Who can/has access to the data?

Only Euronav staff/contractors with relevant permissions have access to the data. For sales and similar operations the information may be accessed by sales, accounts, management or engineering staff in helping to supply your ordered products.

Third parties such as the UKHO or credit card companies will receive only the information they need to process your order.

What procedures, systems and controls are in place to secure the data? We will take steps to ensure that appropriate security measures are utilised to protect your personal data, as required by GDPR.

Sensitive information in our control is protected by a number of means including physical access restrictions, encryption etc.

International data transfers

We do not transfer personal data outside the European Economic Area unless it's a requirement and only to the extent to fulfil your order, such as a licence you are purchasing from an overseas data provider.

Other providers such as credit card companies may have their own policies and guarantees about the data provided.

What we don't do

Aggregate your data with data from other sources

Supply you data outside Euronav Ltd unless it's part of an order fulfilment process. Profilina

Your rights relating to your personal data
